Application Process

1. Apply to CSI.
2. Take the Compass Test.
3. Complete all of the minimum prerequisites for admission.
4. Apply to the Paramedic Program.

Admission preference is given to students who have met all of the required prerequisites, possess documented health care experience and show a demonstrated commitment to the field of EMS.

Every effort will be made to admit eligible candidates into the program. In the event however, there are more candidates than places available eligible candidates will be placed first on a list for admission for the following course.
