Surgical technologists are specially trained to work in surgery and are the experts in the field of aseptic technique, sterilization techniques and instrumentation. Surgical technologists when working in the operating room usually function in the “scrub” role. In this role they do a traditional surgical hand scrub, gown and glove, set up the sterile supplies and instruments, pass the instruments to the surgeon and assistant during the operation.
